Teams will be mailed acceptance or rejection letters *starting* June 30 (and by return-mail thereafter). Rejected teams will receive a full refund and be put on a waiting list. Tournament schedules, rules, and roster sheets will be mailed by or before August 15.

**Cancellations:** If accepted teams cancel by letter postmarked on or before July 1, they will receive a full refund. Teams canceling after July 15 will forfeit their registration fee, unless another team takes their place from the waiting list.
